... **INGREDIENTS** ...

- 1 - Cup of Sugar
- 3 - Egg Yolks, Beaten
- 4 - Tablespoons of Flour
- 6 - Tablespoons of Butter
- 2 - Cups of Milk
- 1 - Teaspoon of Vanilla
- 1/4 - Cup Cocoa

Mix sugar, cocoa and flour together in a saucepan. Add milk, eggs and butter. Cook mixture over medium heat stirring constantly until thickened.

Remove from heat and add vanilla.

Pour into a nine inch baked pie shell.

Use cool whip, whipped cream or ice cream to top off the pie. Meringue topping is not recommended for topping on this pie.
