A New Way to Pay

CheckOut brings a convenient way to pay your electric bill in cash

Tri-County Electric Co-op members now have a new way to pay: CheckOut. Members who wish to pay their bill in cash can visit one of 2,500 participating locations, including Dollar General, Family Dollar and CVS. Members can still pay using autodraft, online through the member portal or TCEC Connect, by phone, in person and by mail. 800666171

Andrea McCleese, director of Member Service, says CheckOut offers members who want to pay their bill in cash a more convenient option. 8000861501

"The billing statement has a barcode printed on the back that can be scanned by a cashier at one of those stores," she said. "They accept the payment, and it posts to the member's account in real time. For people who like to take care of this in cash, in person, this may offer a better opportunity, with longer hours." 9852001

Poppy Seed Bread Martha Crosby of Cool

BREAD

3 cups flour 1 1/3 cup Crisco oil 1 1/2 tsp. salt 3 eggs 1 1/2 tsp. baking soda 1 1/2 tsp. almond extract 1 1/2 tsp. poppy seeds 1 1/2 tsp. vanilla 2 1/2 cups sugar 1 1/2 cup milk

GLAZE

3/4 cup sugar1/2 tsp. almond extract1/3 cup orange juice2 tbsp. butter1/2 tsp. vanilla

Bake at 350°F for 1 hour and 15 minutes for large loaves or 55 minutes for mini loaves.

To make the glaze, heat and stir all ingredients in a sauce pan until sugar dissolves. Pour over bread while glaze and bread are hot.
