

Cost-of-Service Study Findings

- -Cost-of-Service Study Conducted by Third-Party
 - Removed current solar members from Residential Rate Class
 - Created a new class for current solar rate
 - Allocated appropriate revenues and costs to determine rate base and return
- -Average Monthly kWh for Residential Rate Class: 1,560
- -Average Monthly kWh for Current Solar Rate Class: 811
- -Annual Rate of Return for Residential Rate Class: 4.12%
- -Annual Rate of Return for Current Solar Rate Class: 3.52%

Overview: Current Members w/ Solar

Keeping Current Terms

You can keep your grandfathered rate, buyback at a one-for-one up to net zero at the retail rate.

Switch to New Terms

You can also move to new program terms, which include a straightforward structure and a buyback program for all energy exported to the grid.

Current Members w/ Solar – Grandfathered Rate Structure

- Buy back at one-for-one up to net zero at the retail rate.
- Minimum monthly bill: \$30
 - \$18 Customer Charge
 - \$12 Distributed Generation Charge
- -Array is capped at 50 kW AC.

Applies to current solar members or members who apply by March 1, 2024.

Current Members w/ Solar – Grandfathered Rate Program Details

- The grandfathered rate will apply to the current system <u>ONLY</u>.
 - Members have until March 1, 2024, to submit applications for interconnection under the grandfathered rate.
 - Members must obtain Permission to Operate (PTO) by September 1, 2024, or will adopt the new program terms.
 - If changes or additions are made after March 1, 2024, the member will adopt the new program terms.
- Members will pay Brazos Financing Rider on all purchased kWh.
- The grandfathered rate is non-transferable and will terminate upon final billing.
- The grandfathered rate begins March 2024 and expires after 10 years.
- Members can switch to the new rate at any time.
 - Members cannot switch back to the grandfathered rate after switching to the new rate.

Applies to current members with solar or members who apply by March 1, 2024.

Overview: Future Members w/ Solar

Straightforward Structure

You'll receive a credit for all the energy you export to the grid, and you'll pay for the energy you use.

Valuing Overproduction

We have a buyback program for excess energy you export to the grid at avoided cost. We'll pay you what we would have paid if we had to purchase the energy elsewhere.

We're Here to Help

Our team of trusted energy advisors are ready to answer questions and work with you on which program may work best for your household.

New Solar Rate Structure

- Members will receive credit for all exported energy at avoided cost, which is calculated monthly.
- -Members can bank unused credits from month to month with no cap on dollars.
- -Member payments for unused credits will be paid out by March 31 each year and banks will be zeroed out.

Applies to solar applications received after March 1, 2024.

New Solar Rate Program Details


- Members will pay for all purchased kWh at the retail rate.
- Members will pay the Brazos Financing Rider on all purchased kWh.
- Minimum monthly bill: \$30
 - \$18 Customer Charge
 - \$12 Distributed Generation Charge
- Array is capped at 50 kW AC.

Applies to solar applications received after March 1, 2024.
