



Summer Safety Tips

Remember these rules for safe pool-time fun this summer!

Keep electric radios, TVs, grills, lights and other electrical appliances at least 10 feet from pools and wet surfaces. Use battery-powered appliances whenever possible.

Electric appliances should not be used outdoors unless they have a heavy-duty cord and three-pronged plug.



All outdoor electrical outlets should be weatherproof and equipped with a ground-fault circuit interrupter.

Swimming pools should be well away from overhead wires to avoid contact when using long-handled equipment.

If you think you are being shocked while in the water, move away from the source of shock. Get out of the water, if possible, without using a metal ladder. 8647200002

Stay safe this summer. Don't swim with shocks!

July 2018 Member Information Bulletin

Bean Bake Sharon J. Cobbs of Springtown



1 pound small white navy beans 1 quart water 1 teaspoon salt 1 can Hunt's Manwich sauce 2 tablespoons molasses 1 small onion, quartered 3 slices bacon

Cover beans with water in large kettle. Bring to boil for 2 minutes. Remove from heat. Cover. Let stand for 1 hour.

Add salt. Bring to a boil and simmer 2 hours until most of liquid is absorbed and beans are almost tender.

Add Hunt's Manwich sauce and molasses. Mix well.

Place onion in bottom of 2-quart casserole or bean pot. Add beans mixture. Lay bacon slices over bean mixture. Cover.

Bake at 300°F for 3 to 4 hours. Add water, a little at a time, as needed.
