11/2 to 2 lbs of grapes, color of your choice Small box of jello, flavor of your choice

Empty dry jello into a bowl or ziplock bag.

Remove grapes from stems and place in a colander. Rinse well and drain.

While grapes are still slightly wet, drop a handful into the dry jello and roll. Remove grapes and put in another bowl. Repeat until all grapes are covered.

Place bowl of grapes in the refrigerator for 2 to 4 hours, or until chilled. 800829260
