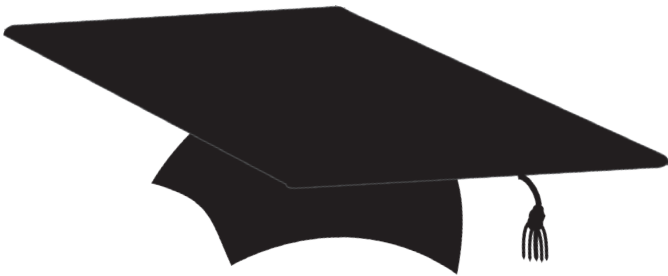

- 2 boxes frozen chopped spinach
- 2 cups stuffing mix (preferably Pepperidge Farm brand)
- 4 eggs
- 1 chopped onion
- ¾ cup melted butter
- ½ cup parmesan cheese
- ½ teaspoon garlic salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper
- ½ cup water 15679007
- ¼ teaspoon thyme

Combine all ingredients and chill for 1 hour.

Form mixture into balls.

Bake at 350°F for 15-20 minutes.
